Innovation in Automation



Overview 2019/20

- Revenue achieved c£5.9M (Previous best £4.5M 2018/19)
- Profit before tax and management charges c £558k (after tax c £770k)
- A great year
 - Excellent order intake combined with increased margins
 - Efficient use of labour



Results 2020/21

- Revenue achieved c£3.9M (Previous £5.9M 2019/20)
- Profit before tax and management charges c £189k (after tax c £480k)
- Sales
 - Orders received 2020/21 £5.3M
 - Carryover Orderbook 2020/21 to 2021/22 £2.25M
- A challenging year for obvious reasons...
 - Effect of Pandemic



Effect of Covid Pandemic

- Sales
 - March 2020 July 2021 Order intake virtually stopped
 - End of Lockdown 1 Orders switched back on
 - January 2021 April 2021 Order intake very slow
 - End of Lockdown 3 Orders switched back on
- Resource
 - Resource that could work from home did
 - Challenging given poor internet connectivity
 - Approx 60% of the team remained in the office / factory or on client sites
 - Difficult for employees in factory and on client sites given challenges faced with social distancing, masks etc
 - Few members of team have had Covid but no outbreak on site causing effect
 - All resource returned to office July 2020
 - Furlough scheme used where appropriate to support lulls in workload





- We will soon be moving






Our new facility located on Hartlebury trading estate boasts:

Overview 2019/20

- Revenue achieved c£945k (Previous best £755k 2018/19)
- Profit before tax and management charges c £16k (after tax c £75k)
- The year we turned to profit
 - Slow start to the year due to order intake
 - Second half excellent order intake combined with increased margins
 - Efficient use of Labour



Results 2020/21

- Revenue achieved c1.2£M (Previous £945k 2019/20)
- Profit before tax and management charges c £165k (after tax c£227k)
- Sales
 - Orders received 2020/21 £1.6M
 - Carryover Orderbook 2020/21 to 2021/22 £557k
- An excellent year
 - Clearly some impact due to pandemic but this didn't depress orders


